## Content

Candidates work will involve the following:

## Assessment Criteria

The course has defined assessment objectives and these are measured using the following criteria:

- Techniques – use a wide range of physical and vocal skills
- Communication – verbal and non-verbal, working spontaneously
- Planning and contextual awareness – respond to a variety of content
- Present information, ideas and opinions coherently
- Interact with individuals, groups and audiences

## Course Aims

The Professional Certificate in Communication Skills is intended to provide a framework relevant to all professional, social and networking situations in which communication is paramount. The attainment of this internationally recognised certification will benefit those who are seeking to further their professional careers. This course will also be useful for those who are wishing to develop their creative talents and build confidence in presenting, expression and spontaneity.

## Learning Outcomes

For successful completion of this certificate course candidates will be required to:

- Show considerable competency in delivering detailed presentations, using a variety of aids while demonstrating a vivid and powerful use of spoken language
- Respond to questions with authority and engage in discussion with sensitivity and conviction
- Show mature understanding of varying communication situations and needs
- Utilise interpersonal and vocal skills that enable them to communicate appropriately
- Use different approaches to solve problems
- Communicate accurately with clear intent
- Operate in moderately critical situation where success depends on choosing appropriate responses
